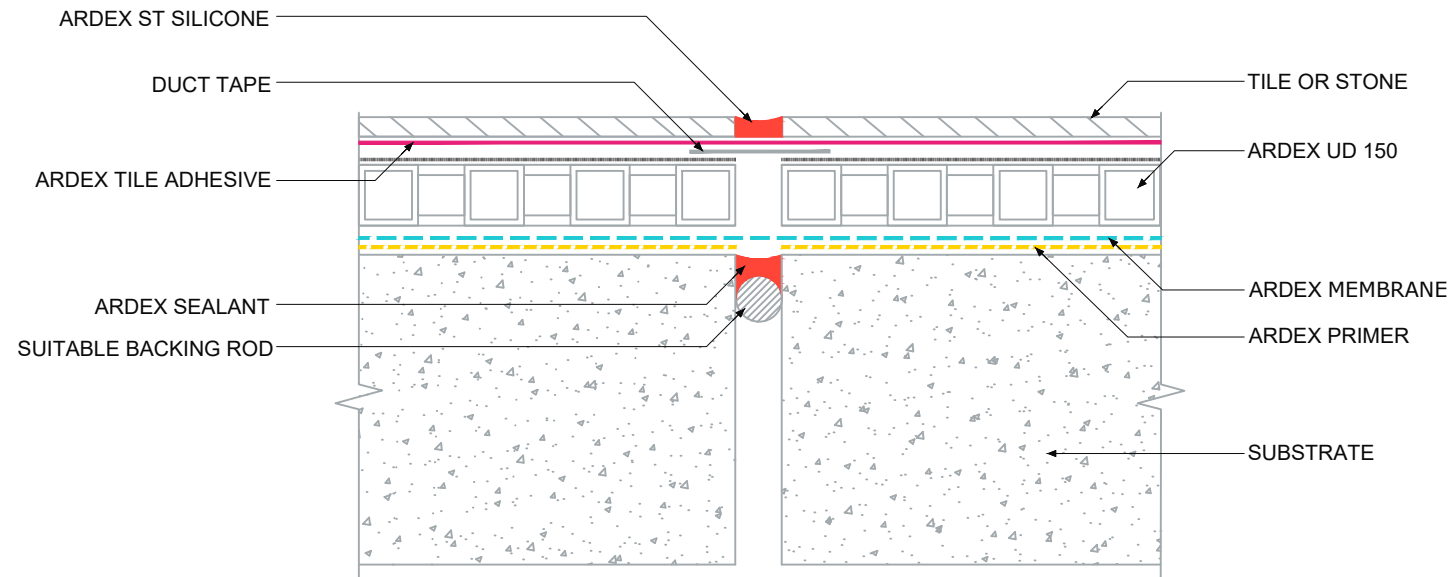
NOTES

Joint detailing for the ARDEX MEMBRANE will differ depending on specific membrane being applied and potential joint movement (to be determined by project consultant).

The type of ARDEX SEALANT to be used will differ depending on specific membrane being applied and potential joint movement (to be determined by project consultant).

The use of duct tape is to prevent entry of tile adhesive into the joint.

After the ARDEX Waterproofing Membrane has been applied and the floor movement joints detailed accordingly, cut the ARDEX UD 150 mat where necessary and provide a 5mm minimum gap between sheets over the joint (excluding construction joints). The exact joint width of a construction joint must be honoured through the ARDEX UD 150 mat and finished tiled surface.
